The Occupational Programs team has been working on updates and improvements to our <u>eLearning programs in Workday</u>. One of the newest developments is utilizing features in Workday that enables the automatic assignment, notification, and tracking of eLearning courses for FM employees and supervisors when appropriate.

What does this mean for you?

- → As an employee, you will be notified in Workday and Outlook prior to the due date for important eLearning courses. Please read and respond to notifications in a timely manner.
- → As a leader, if you receive an email regarding an eLearning class for an employee, please be sure they complete their assigned course.

Employees or supervisors who receive unexpected or incorrect training notifications should reach out to <u>FM-OHS@virginia.edu</u> for clarification as training requirements may have recently changed.

This is the first in many efficiencies created by Workday Learning. Developments in 2024 will include self-enrolling in live courses on the date(s) and time(s) that works best for you, as well as the ability to add the event to your UVA Outlook calendar.

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY Did You Know? Hand Safety and Injury Protection

A serious injury to your fingers or hands can result in a negative impact on your ability to work and your quality of life. Common causes of hand injuries are carelessness, lack of awareness, boredom, and distractions.




Hand Protection Best Practices:

- → Use guards provided and use the tool per the manufacturer recommendations.
- → Never put your hand in an area where you cannot see it.
- → Always wear the proper hand protection for the task you are doing. Understand the limitations of your gloves and what tasks they are appropriate for.
- → Never work on an energized piece of equipment.
- → Use the right tool for the job.

Financial stress can adversely affect our emotional and physical health as well as our relationships and productivity.  - → A classroom or auditorium presentation for CTE students or students interested in starting a hands-on career following high school.
 - → A virtual Zoom session can be scheduled with a group for a Q&A session with a program representative and/or current apprentice.

- ★ Recruitment runs January 2024 April 2024.
- ★ Applications will be accepted via <u>UVA Workday</u> between March and April 2024.

SEASONAL REMINDERS

SAFETY SHOES & WINTER BOOTS REMINDERS

FM does not use shoe issue date to determine eligibility. FM has found that the shoe life varies among FM trades and departments. To best serve those that need shoes more often or less frequently, employees & supervisors must request replacement shoes via the <u>online request form</u> no later than 7 days before the scheduled shoe truck visit. It is the supervisor's responsibility to review & approve or deny shoe voucher requests and to keep their employees in compliance with their safety shoes, winter boots, other PPE, and replacement insoles. Eligible employees will use their UVA ID badge and Red Wing voucher to pick up shoes at the truck.

Safety Shoes & One Login

FM IT is currently working to convert IT systems to use <u>one login</u>. For now, **your login to the FM Shoe Request Form will remain behind your <u>old</u> FM password.** This is expected to update by the end of the year.

Here's how to access the shoe request and other FM forms:

- 1. Open the shoe form https://at.virginia.edu/FMShoeRequest
- 2. Your login will be:
 - ★ Username is FM\your computing ID (ex: FM\mst3k)
 (Tip: The \ key is above the enter key on a computer keyboard.)
 - ★ Password is your OLD FM computer login password, not the one you just set. If you can't remember your old password, contact the FM IT Help Desk at (434) 982-5579 or fmhdticket@virginia.edu to have it reset.

Winter Boots

If needed, winter boots are available to UVA employees that must work snow/cold weather duty. *Winter boot distribution is at supervisor discretion*. **To request a winter boot voucher the employee or their supervisor can submit a request via the safety shoe request form: https://at.virginia.edu/
FMShoeRequest** — Employee requests will go to your supervisor for review and approval.

If you have a new employee starting and you would like them to pick up winter boots during onboarding, please email FM-OHS@virginia.edu prior to their start date.

REMINDERS:

- → The Shoe Truck is at UVA FM on Tuesdays that coincide with New Employee Safety Training. 7:00-8:00 AM is reserved for new employees to pick up shoes.
- → Employees needing safety shoes should submit a request via the online portal: https://at.virginia.edu/FMShoeRequest
- → Vouchers will be released weekly via email and text (if available).
- → Winter boots are expected to last employees for several years, as our winters have been mild.
- $\rightarrow\,$ The LAST shoe truck of 2023 will be on Tuesday, Dec. 5.
