Tools for Your Toolbox: Protect Yourself & Others from Illness

Viruses that cause illnesses like flu, COVID-19, and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) are especially active in winter. Take care to protect yourself and others from becoming infected:

- → **Get immunized!** Flu & COVID-19 shots are covered by your UVA insurance. Talk to your doctor if you would like to know more about RSV immunization.
- → Seek testing if you have symptoms or have been exposed Tests, some of which are available for at-home use, can quickly detect these viruses so you can quickly seek treatment and take action to protect your family, friends, and coworkers.
- → Effective treatments are widely available Anti-viral medications are available for flu and COVID-19 and can reduce the likelihood of severe illness, hospitalization, and death.
- → Masking, physical distancing, washing hands, and improving airflow in the places where you live and work provide additional protection for everyone.

If you must drive in wintery conditions, make sure to do so safely! Here are some tips to keep you and others on the road safe:

- → Make a plan. Notify your supervisor you are on the way or may be late.
- → Increase your follow distance: Add 5-6 seconds between you and the person in front of you.
- → Try not to brake hard, slow down progressively.
- → Take your time!
- → Keep your speed steady. This allows better control of the vehicle.
- → Increase and decrease your speed slowly.
- → Keep the vehicle's tank at least half full.
- → Do not use your phone while driving.
