Best Wishes: Victor Brown, Apprenticeship Alumnus!

Victor Brown, plumber senior on the McCormick Road Zone Maintenance team, retired April 1 after more than 41 years. **Brown first joined the University in 1982 as a housekeeper and participated in the UVA Apprenticeship Program from 1988-1992.** He was encouraged to apply for the program by fellow FM staff members who he played basketball with at Slaughter Rec during their lunch break. Brown served the McCormick Zone for the majority of his career, *“opening the walls in every building in the zone”* which serves many research lab spaces, zone manager Randy Campbell wrote in a retirement letter. *“You have worked on lab and research assets that we can't fathom the resulting affect,”* he said. *“You have been a part of research that has changed the way we live and breathe. You have made the environment of those who do the research suitable to accomplish their mission.”* Outside of work, Brown is a talented bass guitar player and a member of the Chickenhead Blues Band. This increases the number of styles available in female sizes. Gratitude is a thankful appreciation for what an individual receives, whether tangible or intangible. It's simply acknowledging the goodness in one's life, and in doing so we are connected to something greater outside of ourselves as individuals; whether that's other people, a higher power, or nature.



[Research](#) shows that practicing gratitude can reduce stress and improve not only mental health, but also physical health. It can even [lower risk](#) of depression, anxiety, and substance misuse.

- Write a small list of 3 things you are grateful for each day.
- Write a thank you note to someone or even to yourself. (You're doing great!)

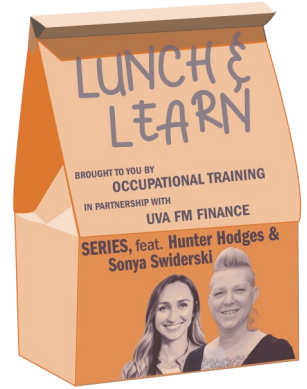
