CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Ivy Corridor – Public Realm Project

ITEMS OF INTEREST:

- **UPDATE FROM ALERT NO. 013** – The full closure of Emmet St scheduled to last through Friday, November 12 will end earlier than planned. The team will reopen Emmet St to vehicular traffic on Thursday, November 11.
- Faulconer Construction Co will be closing the center lane of Ivy Rd each night (8pm – 5:30am) for utility work in the road from Sunday, November 14th through Friday, November 19th, 2021. There will also be some capture of the East side of Emmet St for ongoing utility work.
- Traffic will remain open in all directions on Ivy Rd and Emmet St, both day and night. The center lane of Ivy Rd will be reopened each morning (5:30am – 8pm). Signage for the impacts will be coordinated with the City of Charlottesville.
- Vehicular traffic in Emmet St and Ivy Rd will be open in all directions for the weekends of UVA home football games.
- Pedestrian traffic will be closed on East side of Emmet St and along the North side of Ivy Rd. Pedestrian route from Emmet/Ivy Garage to Central Grounds is to take Rothery Rd to south side of Ivy Road. Pedestrian route from Emmet/Ivy Garage to Lambeth/JPJ/Barracks Rd is to take Rothery Rd to the west side of Emmet St.

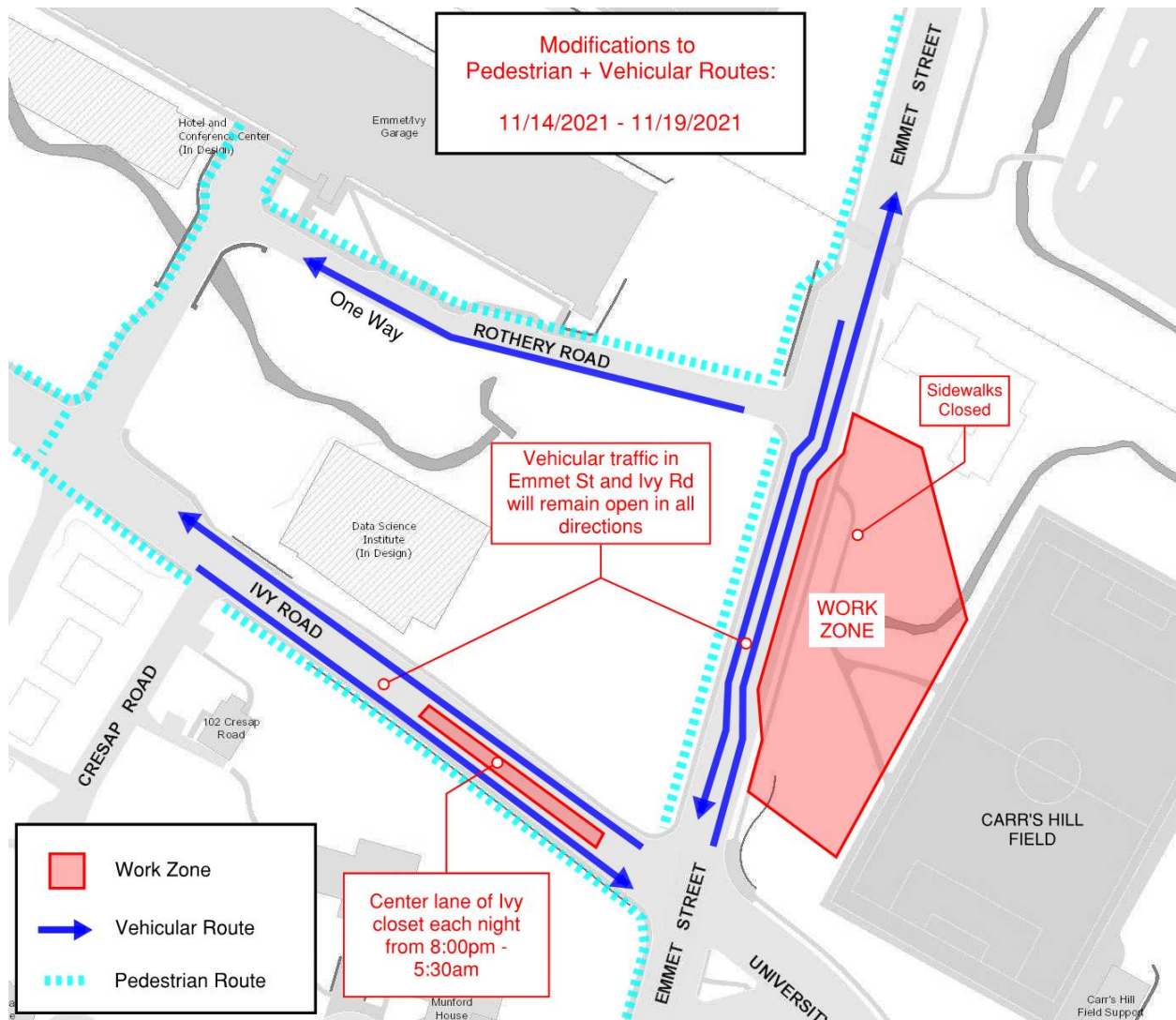
BACKGROUND:
