CONSTRUCTION PROJECT ALERT
CONTEMPLATIVE COMMONS

ITEMS OF INTEREST: Temporary loading dock access drive installation, short-term change to pedestrian detour

BACKGROUND: The Contemplative Commons project will add a new 4-story academic building on the site of an existing surface parking lot adjacent to the Dell Pond and School of Education. New pedestrian bridges will create an ADA connection from Newcomb Plaza to the McCormick Rd Dorm area.

IMPACTS: On 1/18/22, Hourigan Construction will begin work on a temporary access drive to the loading dock at Ridley Hall to enable service vehicles to access the School of Education without going through the Contemplative Commons project construction site. This work will take place outside of the construction fence at the southeast corner of the site, between Emmet Street and the existing loading dock at Ridley Hall. Temporary fencing will be provided to route pedestrians around the area of work. The work will require re-routing the existing pedestrian detour on Emmet Street 1/26-1/31. The loading dock will remain accessible through the construction site until 1/31, when the access drive is completed.

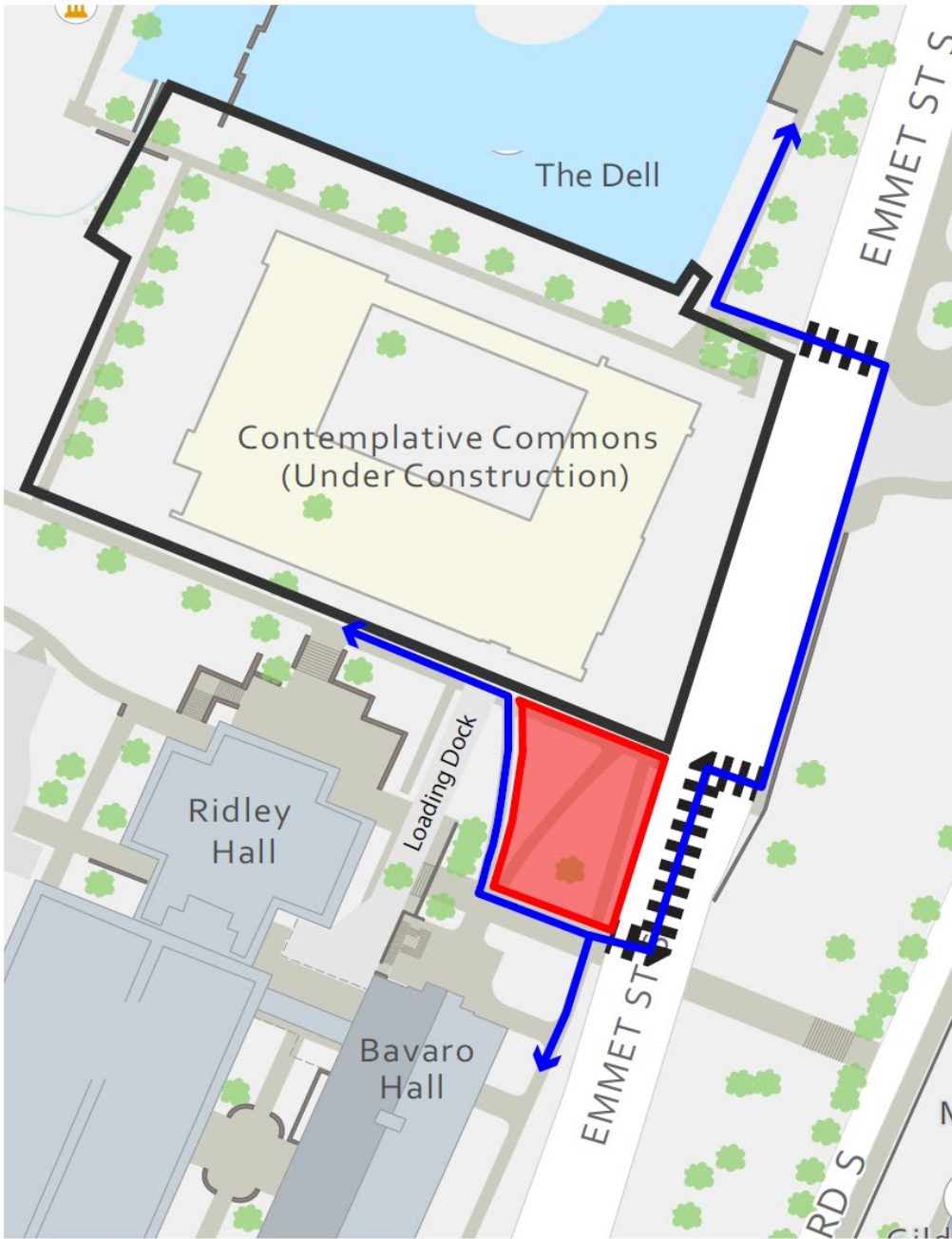

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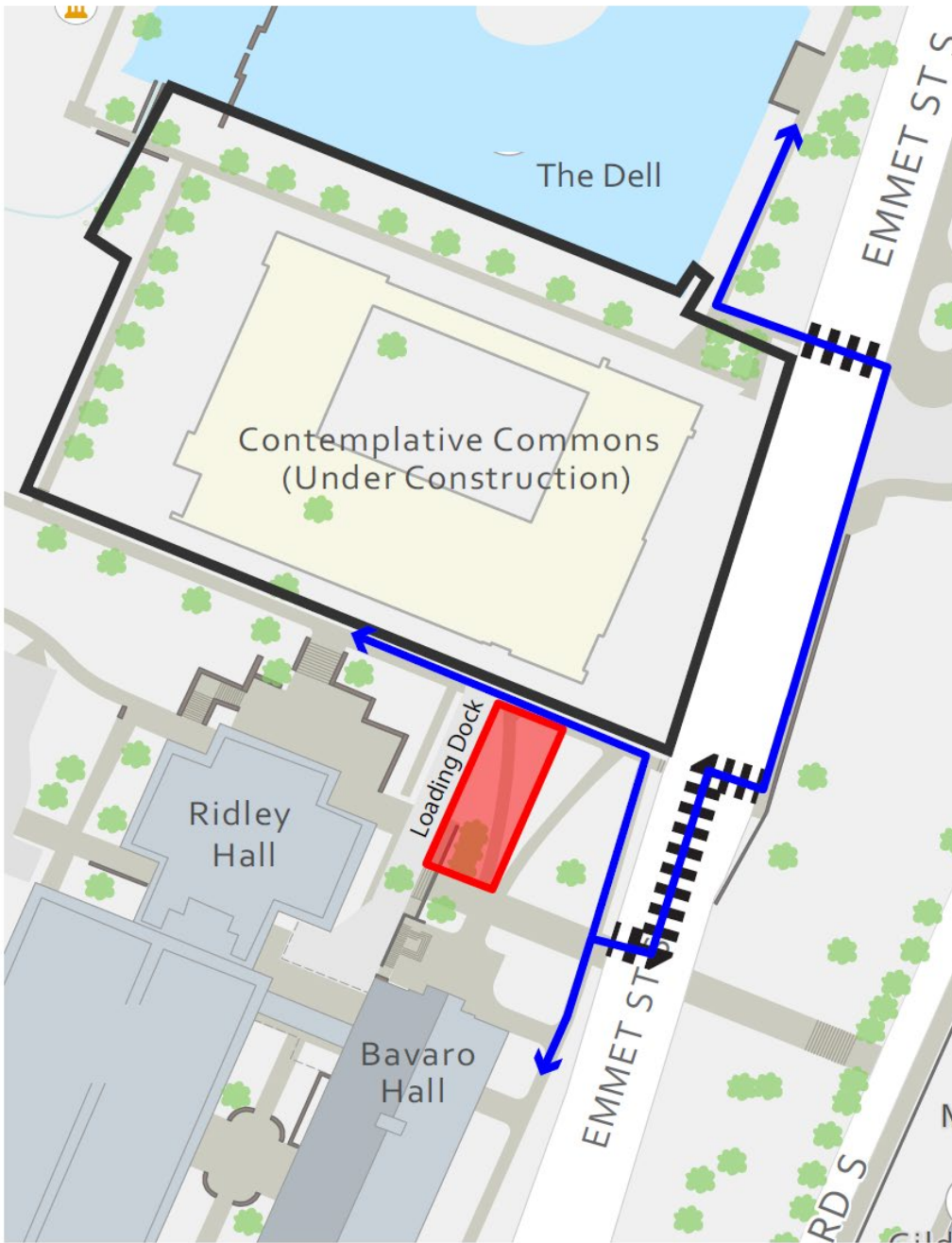
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Phase 1: January 18th - January 25th
