- Vehicles: Starting Monday, March 7th the only <u>entrance</u> to the Emmet-Ivy Garage is from Emmet St. The only <u>exit</u> is onto Ivy Rd.
- Buses: Starting Monday, March 7th the Blue Line will serve EIG from Ivy Rd. The Gold and Silver Line will serve EIG from Emmet St.
- Pedestrians: The sidewalk and bike lane closures along the north side of Ivy Rd. for utility work through Friday, March 18th.
- Pedestrians: The sidewalk on the west side of Emmet St. is closed from Rothery Rd. to the Emmet-Ivy intersection. The sidewalk is scheduled to reopen Monday, March 18th. The east side of the Emmet St. sidewalk is open.
- Pedestrians: The pedestrian route from Emmet-Ivy Garage to Central Grounds is to take Rothery Rd. to the south side of Ivy Rd. The pedestrian route from Emmet/Ivy Garage to Lambeth/JPJ/Barracks Rd. takes Rothery Rd. to the west side of Emmet St.


