## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

### Emmet-Ivy Corridor Public Realm Project Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday, March 11<sup>th</sup>

#### **ITEMS OF INTEREST:**

- Vehicles: Starting Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup> the only entrance to the Emmet-Ivy Garage is from Emmet St. The only exit is onto Ivy Rd.
- Buses: Starting Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup> the Blue Line will serve EIG from Ivy Rd. The Gold and Silver Line will serve EIG from Emmet St.
- Pedestrians: The sidewalk and bike lane closures along the north side of Ivy Rd. for utility work through Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Pedestrians: The sidewalk on the west side of Emmet St. is closed from Rothery Rd. to the Emmet-Ivy intersection. The sidewalk is scheduled to reopen Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>. The east side of the Emmet St. sidewalk is open.
- Pedestrians: The pedestrian route from Emmet-Ivy Garage to Central Grounds is to take Rothery Rd. to the south side of Ivy Rd. The pedestrian route from Emmet/Ivy Garage to Lambeth/JPJ/Barracks Rd. takes Rothery Rd. to the west side of Emmet St.

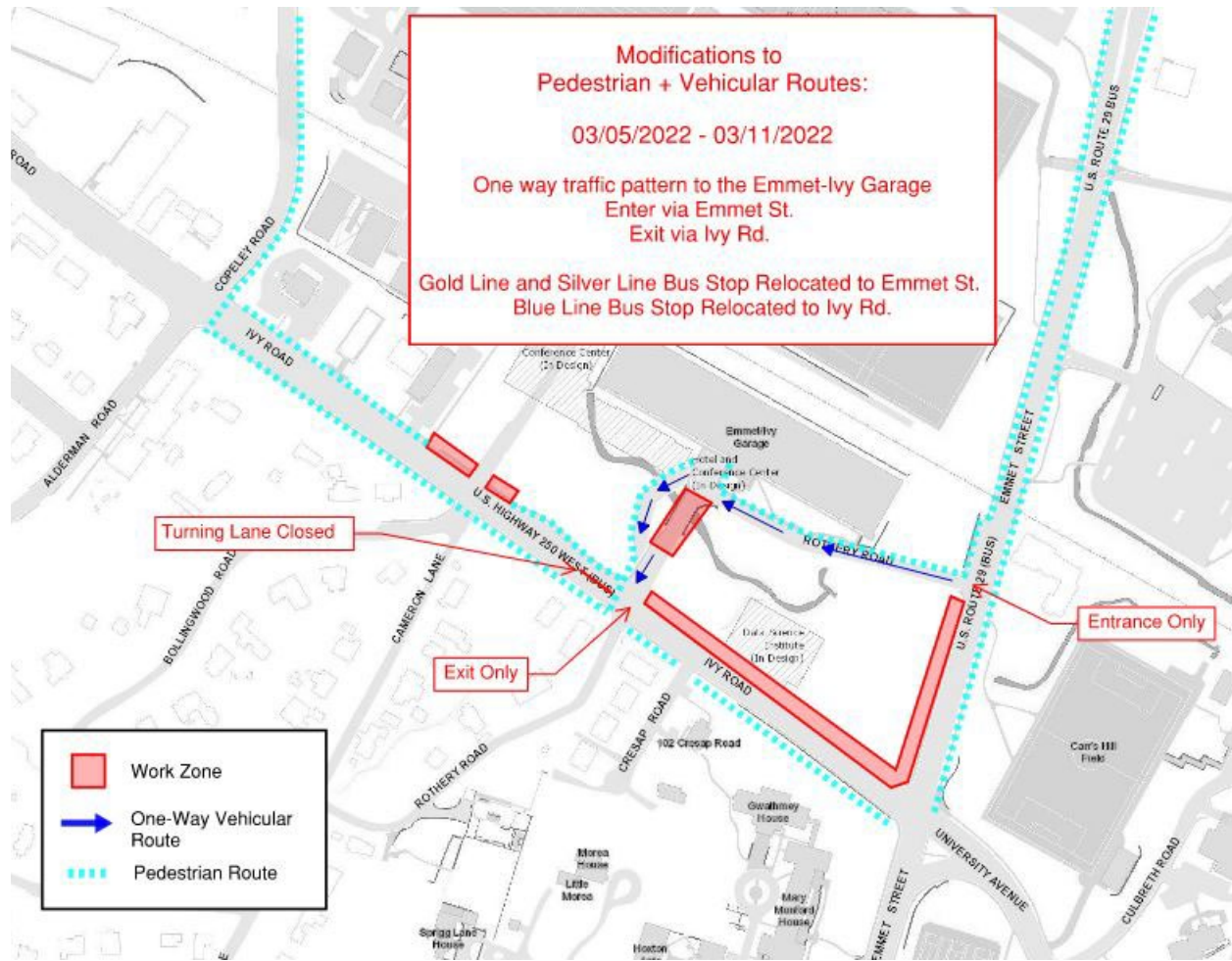
#### **BACKGROUND:**
