Saturday, June 1st - Sunday, June 2nd****WHAT'S THE LATEST CHANGE?**


The Virginia Guesthouse project must dismantle one of the two cranes necessary to install the pre-cast exterior brick panels. The crane (396 feet tall) must be dismantled on the ground, and the dimensions exceed those available inside the fence. Consequently, the crane will extend across Rothery Rd. and into the west lawn of the School of Data Science. The support crane will also sit in the middle of Rothery Rd. for the duration of the process. A series of tractor trailers will be loading and unloading material throughout the process.

Vehicles: The Emmet/Ivy Garage and Rothery Rd. will be closed on Saturday, June 1st, from 5:00 am until 10:00 pm on Sunday, June 2nd.

Pedestrians: The sidewalks on the east and west side of Rothery Rd. will be closed on Saturday, June 1st and Sunday, June 2nd.

Pedestrians: The sidewalk on the north side of Ivy Rd. will be closed from Copeley Rd. to the UTS Blue Line bus stop. The sidewalk closure will remain in place until the completion of the Karsh Institute of Democracy, anticipated for Q3 2026. The pedestrian route on the south side of Ivy Rd. will remain open.
