CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Amphitheatre Structural Repairs

ITEMS OF INTEREST:

- Seven micropiles will be installed at the amphitheater on Monday December 22nd and Tuesday December 23rd.
- This work will generate noticeable and potentially disruptive noise as the micropiles are drilled into the bedrock beneath the amphitheater.
- Work will begin on the stage side at 10:00 Monday. These first three will have amplified sound, due to the acoustics of the amphitheater itself, into the surrounding area.
- After Monday if any micropiles remain to be installed, they will be installed starting at 7:00 am.

EXIT & SIDEWALK ACCESSIBILITY

- Work blocks existing building exits, and was reviewed with OUBO prior to blockage.
- Work blocks existing sidewalks, and was reviewed with OUBO prior to blockage.
- No impact to existing building exits and sidewalks.


BACKGROUND:

- The amphitheater was constructed in 1920, designed by Fiske Kimball, and has been used for many events and gatherings over the years.
- After a previous project to remove a failing modern coating on the amphitheater, it was noted that a section of the amphitheater needed repairs to its structural system. Shoring was installed as a precautionary measure and will be maintained until the structural repair is completed.
- The larger construction project is still slated to be finished in March of 2026.
