C4A Infrastructure Improvements

Construction Fence Setup

Items of interest

Beginning the week of August 10, fencing will be installed around the C4A building footprint in preparation for the UVA Energy and Utilities project, C4A infrastructure improvements.

Most of this work will take place within the fenced area; however, a small portion will occur on the north promenade. During this work, the pedestrian route will be temporarily redirected.

Vehicles should expect occasional delays entering and exiting the garage due to construction vehicles on Rothery Road as the primary project entrance and exit.

Background

As part of the preparation for the future Center for the Arts (C4A), UVA will begin adjustments to district utilities in and around the future building footprint. This utility work is the first phase of site preparation and is necessary before construction of the new building can begin.

The future Center for the Arts will be located on Parcels 8 and 9 within the Ivy Corridor. The approximately 210,610-square-foot facility will bring together performing arts spaces, the Fralin Museum of Art, the Kluge-Ruhe Art Collection, and the Department of Music in a shared academic building.
