CONSTRUCTION ALERT

CITY OF CHARLOTTESVILLE WEST MAIN UTILITIES REPLACEMENT

Culbreth Rd.

Vehicles:

Beginning Monday, **July 6, through July 27**, the City of Charlottesville will begin a gas line replacement project on Culbreth Road.

Most of the work will be completed using directional drilling/boring, which will occur underground and is expected to have little to no impact on traffic. However, two areas along the route will require open-trench construction.

During open-trench operations, Culbreth Road will remain open, but traffic will be reduced to one alternating lane in the work zone. Flaggers will be on site to direct vehicular traffic and assist motorists through the area safely.

Pedestrians: Sidewalks will remain open.

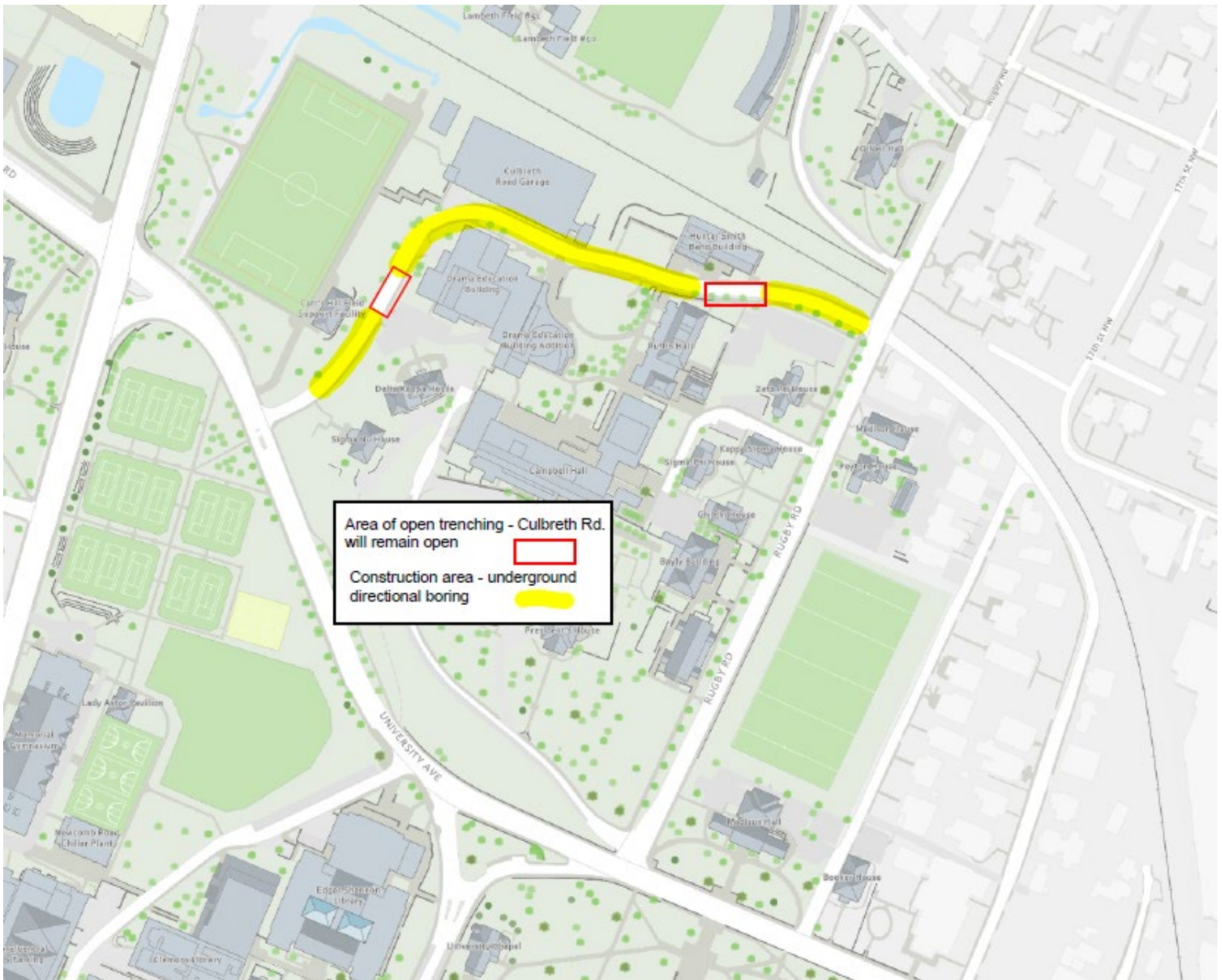
Please note: The Charlottesville Department of Utilities is preparing to launch the West Main Street Utilities Replacement Project, a major infrastructure investment designed to strengthen utility services for decades to come. A continuation of Utilities' city-wide implementation of planned infrastructure improvements, this project will be a multi-year effort conducted in phases, replacing aging gas and water mains along University Avenue, West Main Street, and select side streets. This project represents a strategic investment in Charlottesville's future, with Phase One scheduled to begin in summer 2026.
