LOBBY REFRESH

The School of Nursing at McLeod Hall wished to upgrade the appearance of their main entry lobby to reflect a more contemporary look and to honor a donor. 3D rendered images were created to demonstrate the appearance of the space for the client. The built appearance matched the image. potential.

Key Elements:

- Reimagine an existing curved wall lobby expression with an expanded digital media and signage display.
- Provide a contemporary panelized wall system to replace an existing dated assembly.
- Include additional built-in display cabinets elsewhere in the lobby.

West Complex Central Wing

PLASTIC SURGERY RENOVATION

The Central Wing of the West Complex is constructed as a series of separate buildings were eventually included this four-level building. Today, the fourth floor suite is utilized by the Plastic Surgery department for office space. The goal of this project was to convert a conference room into the Chair's office, expand the other conference room, restore the existing windows, and relocate the restroom.

Key Elements:

- Lead the design effort in one of the original hospital's core historical spaces.
- Manage all architectural and almost all engineering work in-house.
- Successfully deliver a suite of spaces rich in historical and modern detailing with a prevalence of built-in cabinetry and trim.



HISTORICAL CONTEXT

Originally constructed in 1899 as a standalone building, this wing of the West Complex served as the University’s first hospital. This four-level building originally contained an operating theater, solarium, labs, and 25 patient beds.

Reimagined Over the Years

The original use of this space has long since been repurposed as the University hospital has expanded beyond the West Complex. During those periods of expansion, this space has been reimagined a number of times that resulted in many of the exterior windows being covered and uncovered as part of the renovations.
