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OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY DID YOU KNOW?: LADDER SAFETY

Whether you're about to start a new job task or start putting up those holiday decorations, make sure to include these steps in your plan!

- ${\it o}~$ Rungs Check for broken split, cracked, corroded or missing rungs.
- ⊘ Side Rails Check for broken, split, cracked, corroded or missing side rails.
- $\sigma\,$ Cracks Check carefully for cracks; they are hard to see.
- Hardware Check for ladders with loose, corroded, or weakened fasteners and hardware.
- Capacity Check the capacity label and make sure the ladder has sufficient capacity to hold you and everything you are wearing/carrying.
- ${\cal O}~$ Be sure to clear the ground area around the ladder before climbing.
- ${\it o}~$ Make sure all four feet of the ladder are on a firm, dry, level surface.
- ${\it o}~$ Always wear proper footwear with good tread when climbing.
- ${\it o}~$ Keep your body centered on the middle of the ladder.
- ${\it o}~$ Do not lean to reach items while standing on the ladder.
- ${\it o}~$ Do not stand on the top two steps of the ladder unless they are designed for standing.
- ${\it o}~$ Watch for people working under or around the ladder.



Get free at-home COVID-19 tests this winter

Every U.S. household is eligible to order 4 free at-home COVID-19 tests.

Order Free At-Home Tests

Need help placing an order for your at-home tests? Call <u>1-800-232-0233</u> (TTY <u>1-888-720-7489</u>).

If you already have plenty of COVID-19 tests, check to see if their expiration dates have been updated by the FDA: <u>https://at.virginia.edu/bWV3TP</u> The USPS Is once more sending 4 FREE COVID-19 tests to each household that requests them go to <u>https://www.covid.gov/</u> <u>tests</u> to request yours.

Your health insurance will also cover at-home over-the counter <u>COVID-19 tests</u>. Use your card at the pharmacy.

Individuals without insurance can access COVID-19 vaccines through local <u>community health</u> <u>centers</u> or a <u>community testing</u> <u>site:.</u>

What to Do: Symptoms or Illness

Any employee who is experiencing <u>symptoms of illness</u> (COVID-19, cold, or flu) should isolate, notify their supervisor, consult their healthcare provider or contact Employee Health, and get tested.

UVA team members who are required to follow UVA Health's <u>policy OCH-002</u> should go to Employee Health at 400 Brandon Avenue (former Student Health location) for walk-in symptomatic COVID-19 testing between 8 am and noon or between 1pm and 4 pm, Monday through Friday. If UVA Health team members receive positive COVID-19 test results outside of UVA Health or Employee Health, they are required to notify <u>Employee Health</u> at 434-924-2013 or <u>employeehealth@virginia.edu</u>. (This requirement does not apply to other Academic Division employees.)

COVID-19 Vaccine Updates

Updated (also called "bivalent") COVID-19 boosters are available for anyone over 5 years of age. The Virginia Department of Health is encouraging everyone who is eligible to get a COVID-19 vaccine or booster shot before we gather for the winter holidays. Locally, the Blue Ridge Health District is hosting a number of community vaccine clinics in November and December. Find the clinic schedule on their vaccination webpage or search in VASE+ to schedule an appointment. Now is a great time to build extra protection!

Reminder for Employees with HSAs

Employees with a UVA-affiliated HSA account with Chard-Snyder must complete the <u>Electronic Consent Form</u> no later than <u>January 13, 2023</u> to transfer their funds to the new Fidelity HSAs.
