- → Functional Movement Workshops: Learn the best way to "stretch & flex" to prepare for work through discussion of concepts and actual stretching demonstrations with North Grounds Assistant Manager for Zone Operations Katarina Radovic. Functional movement exercise plays a crucial role in FM work environments for several reasons: job performance enhancement, injury prevention and improved flexibility. Just like professional athletes, workers are industrial athletes and should consistently stretch before starting their shifts. It's a small investment with significant returns in terms of safety, health, and job performance.

- ★ Mental Health Awareness: Review the stats for suicide in construction as they compare to Focus Four Hazards (falls, caught-in, struck-by, electrocution).
- ★ What it means to be a leader in safety.





- ★ The average delay between onset of mental illness symptoms and treatment is 11 years.
- **★** 50% of all lifetime mental illness begins by age 14 and 75% by age 24.
