Did You Know? Respiratory Protection Week

When effective engineering controls are not feasible, or while they are being instituted, appropriate respirators must be used. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has established a standard, 29 CFR1910.134 Respiratory Protection for regulating the use of respiratory – protective equipment.

FM-OHS implemented the <u>FM Respiratory Protection Program</u> to comply with the OSHA standard and eliminate or minimize UVA FM employee exposure to hazardous airborne contaminants while performing work assignments.

APPRENTICESHIP

Apprenticeship FAQS:

What is a Competency Evaluation?

The hybrid approach measures the individual apprentice's skill acquisition through a combination of specified minimum number of hours of on-the-job training and the successful demonstration of competency as described in a work process schedule. The UVA FM Apprenticeship Program also incorporates additional competency evaluations to confirm of the effectiveness of the training provided on the job through designated trainers within each zone.

How is Competency Assessed?

Competency is evaluated through hands-on and online assessments, with completed online learning modules reviewed by UVA FM subject matter experts—program instructors and on-the-job trainers. Classes provide apprentices with information that complements their on-the-job training, giving them a well-rounded trades education and a reliable knowledge base.

Apprentices meet regularly with the Apprenticeship Program team to review their progress and identify areas for improvement. Supervisors and apprentices also participate in quarterly progress assessments to identify and support apprentices' career goals and growth.
