CALL OR TEXT 911 FOR FIRE, POLICE, AND MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

Fire Emergency

- The Pull fire alarm
- Leave using nearest safe exit
- Use stairs
- Call or text 911

Medical Emergency

- Call or text 911
- Do not move if there is a serious injury
- Provide first aid if trained
- Send someone to direct responders

Suspicious Activity

- Do not touch object
- Do not confront person
- Leave the area
- Call or text 911

Active Attacker

- Run: Evacuate if safe to do so
- Hide: Lock doors and silence phones
- fight: Prepare to defend yourself
 - Call or text 911

Thunderstorm

- 🧎 If you hear thunder, go indoors
- Seek shelter in a building or car
- Wait 30 minutes after the storm to resume outdoor activities

Tornado

- 🤼 Go to lowest floor of building
- Stay away from windows and glass
- Close doors
- Get on floor and cover head

Bomb Threat

Attempt to keep the caller on the line

Gather as much information as possible

Try to get description of device

Call 911 once call has ended
