Subject: Parking and transportation options for employees working on Grounds

From UVA Parking & Transportation:

To improve access to worksites over the next two weeks, parking and transportation options will be modified through at least April 5. Additional information will be issued as we approach April 2 to clarify continued operations.

Permit holders who do not work at the Medical Center:

Parking permit and meter restrictions are lifted in most areas located in Central, West, and North Grounds. Specifics about these temporary changes can be found here <https://parking.virginia.edu/covid-parking-modifications> The Blueline and Central Grounds Shuttle operations are suspended until further notice.

Permit holders who do work at the Medical Center:

- Parking restrictions at the Medical Center remain in place.
- Starting March 23, Blue, Red, and Emmet/Ivy Garage permits will be honored in an expanded commuter parking area around Scott Stadium.
- The lots around Scott Stadium will be served by dedicated UTS “Redline Special” buses Monday-Friday, 5AM-8PM, and the Health System Employee Shuttle after 8PM.
- There will be two well-marked bus stops in the parking area.
- The Redline Special is in lieu of the Redline and Blueline.

This expansion of Scott Stadium parking and consolidation of the Redline and Blueline will allow us to reduce the number of passengers per trip.
